Members called in: Micah Brown, Melanie Lewis, Mitch Burghlea, Kitty O'Keefe, Josh Thomas, Jeff Cox, and Larry Melzer.

1. Announcements and Introductions
 - a. Micah Brown called the meeting to order at 10:00 a.m. and introductions were made.
 - b. A motion from Melanie was made to approve minutes from 6/24/21 and 2nd by Mitch. Kitty to post on website.
 - c. Chair Statement: Micah welcomed members and guests. He shared that the ticket extension tool is the front runner for action item followed by the design locate parameter.
2. OAR Committee Items
 - a. Discuss 'Ticket Length' language-
 - i) Micah recapped that Michelle has been working on language as members were in favor of the 750 feet per ticket per day.
 - ii) Language will reflect the need to work with operators.
 - b. Discuss Mandatory White Paint-
 - i) Micah recapped that Michelle has worked on 1st draft language and members had reviewed that on 5.6.21 OAR meeting. He will review again and follow up with recommendations.
 - ii) Mitch suggested waiting on language after virtual white paint is in place.
 - c. Discuss Design Locate Parameters-
 - i) Micah recapped we had OCC present at last OAR meeting. He stated the language/rules will probably change in OARs.
 - ii) Scott G has been working on language.
 - d. Discuss Mandatory Damage Reporting
 - i) Micah recapped and asked if this needs to be in rule?
 - ii) Scott G. shared if it's in rule it's enforceable.
 - iii) Members agreed to keep this discussion going and look where best to place in rule.
 - e. Paint Remediation
 - i) Micah recapped how Bill 3181 came about (removal of paint) Keep a look at legislature.
 - ii) Micah's recommendation is to place on the caller.
 - iii) Members hope this issue declines once virtual white lining is in place.

3. Old Business-
 - a. Review Ticket Extension Survey results and make recommendation to board.
 - i) Survey results were shared (See Attachment 1)
 - ii) Members reviewed and provided their decision on some questions needed for ticket extension.
 - iii) Micah will recommend to the full board: question 1: As required and question #2: Not to exceed 10 days.

 - i) Keep this action item. Tabled.

 - i) Members reviewed pg. 9 of Standards Manual for definition of Underground Facility and discussion followed:
 - ii) Do we consider pole anchoring a facility? Is this considered an underground facility?
 - iii) pg.28 (11) Do we change/remove statue?
 - iv) Members will continue this discussion.

 - i) Micah shared with members we held a Exploratory Committee meeting on Aug.4th.
 - ii) This committee will be dissolved.
 - iii) Complaint Process will now fall under the OARs committee.

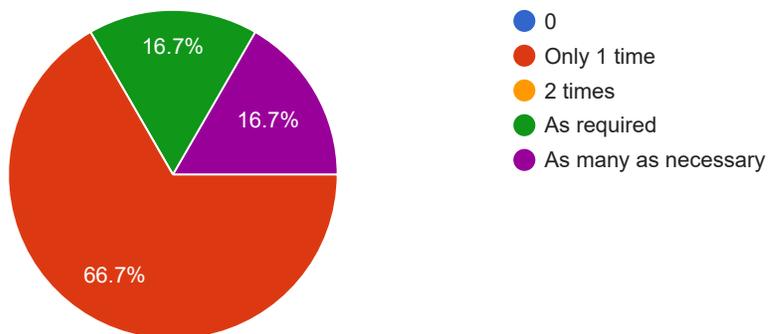

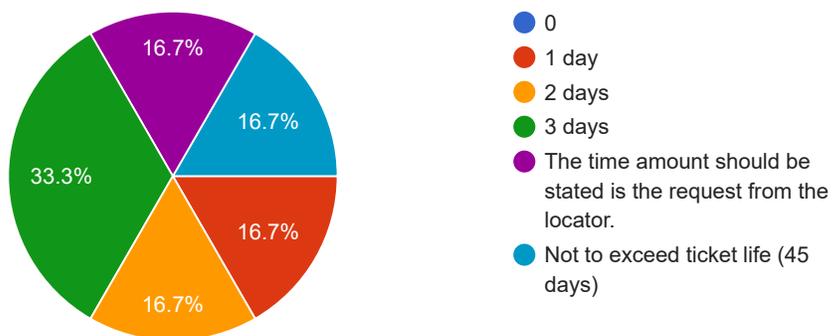
How many ticket extensions should be allowed?

6 responses



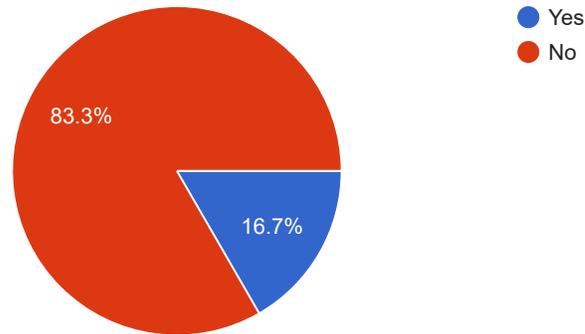
How many days should the extension allow?
