Introductions: Micah welcomed everyone to the meeting and introductions were completed.

Safety Moment – Andy Crocker- Andy shared that it is drowsy driving prevention week. Scott updated the board of the three outstanding enhancements that are being worked on.

- Improved readability on NXT tickets
 - Production Ready
- Expanded ticket reporting
 - In production
- Add homeowner verbiage to emails
 - Will be a part of the next phase release

Scott informed the board that the August and September tariff increase is reflected on the October bill as a separate line item. The net operating receipts show a notable increase reflecting that change.

Scott shared that there has been ongoing issues with homeowners being asked to register with the one call center. When these are received in the future, they will be forwarded to Josh for follow up.

Kevin suggested that there could be shorter videos for each of the specific tools that are shorter. Scott shared that most these already exist at www.or.tryitic.com

OUNC Billing & Aging Report: All Board Members have been emailed copies of the billing reports for the current month.

Treasurer Report: Melanie Lewis. Melanie shared the current board report.

Melanie expressed some concern regarding the pending budget cycle and wants to be sure to keep this on the boards radar.

Melanie poled the board on opinions regarding expected work load for 2023. Generally speaking, all are expecting a flat year.

The 2023 budget will need to be approved at next month's meeting.
